"Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs."

Certain distressing or humiliating memories, we tell ourselves, ought not be shared with anyone. These will remain our secret. Not a soul must ever know. We hope they'll go to the grave with us. Yet if A.A.'s experience means anything to us at all, this is not only unwise, but it is actually a perilous resolve. Few muddled attitudes have caused us more trouble than holding back on Step Five. Some people are unable to stay sober at all; others will relapse periodically until they really clean house.

Concept Five Long Form

Throughout our world service structure, a traditional "Right of Appeal" ought to prevail, thus assuring us that minority opinion will be heard and that petitions for the redress of personal grievances will be carefully considered.

Every member of A.A.'s world service structure has the right to state a minority opinion when they feel the majority has crossed over to the dark side. We have to recognize that there are times when the minority can be right and it is our responsibility to listen to their petition. We have seen many examples where a well stated and well crafted minority opinion can change the outcome entirely.

In the spirit of democracy, allowing the minority opinion to be heard is vital to the unity we profess we must have in Tradition 1. Being able to balance the right of appeal with majority decision ensures we will never be subjected to the tyranny of either the majority or the minority.

Tradition Five

"Each group has but one primary purpose to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers."

It is the great paradox of A.A. that we know we can seldom keep the precious gift of sobriety unless we give it away. This Tradition delineates pretty clearly our individual primary purpose, as well as the group's. Each of us is but a small part of the whole, but by joining AA's primary purpose to our own, we become something bigger than our individual selves.

To work this tradition means that I am willing to say "yes" to this question and rearrange the rest of my priorities. Devoting myself to a new primary purpose means that I am willing to let go of many old ideas. I have many thinking patterns that are automatic that I need to change in order to consecrate myself to a new primary purpose.

She also mentioned one of her volunteers taking calls broke her leg so when we do reopen will need to find alternate to come to office. Discussion was held regarding sellers permit. Kim motioned to table discussion to do research on this until we are in good standing, Shannon seconded, AIF. Melissa said Spectrum bill is going up to 140.00 for internet and phone and said she was going to call to find out why it is increasing so much and/or try and negotiate down.

Discussion was held regarding donations coming into Central Office and it was clarified that we need to send them back with letter from Central Office indicating that we are closed. It was suggested that Melissa send a thank you note with information that the donor can resubmit once we are open. Melissa reported that several donation checks have recently come in the mail and she will send back and keep track of all.

Associate Member: Kim W – Shelly and Kim spent countless hours getting all paperwork for 2018-2024 to the state. Some years needed to be amended. The OAG has not updated the website. Kim reached out via email to find out how long it would take to process all that was submitted and they responded they would get back with her. Kim said they submitted a letter explaining what happen with standing, what was worked on and what will be in place moving forward for Central Office, noting also that she is confident that the issue will be resolved. Shelly said after they worked on all the paperwork to the state she went home and printed 2018-2024 paperwork. She sent it certified mail and postage was \$18.85 which she utilized her Central Office ATM for. She received response back from state on 2/26/2025 which stated: *"Thank you for contacting the Delinquency program in the Registry of Charities and Fundraisers. We are experiencing an unusually high volume of submissions. If you are inquiring about the status of your submission, please know our review may take 45-90 days."*

Raffle: Kim brought up annual donation to convention. Discussed and decided that the office manager will decide what materials to donate, no cash.

Hospitality: Kim said for the convention the committee is asking if they can operate under Central Office's 501c3. at this time With 501c3 in delinquent status they cannot allow convention to use. Since Central Office is closed no donations will be given. Discussion was held and the Alano Club may be willing to donate items for the raffle. Julia stated there is a board meeting today and she will inquire and let the Intergroup Board know.

Increase Discussion 2-15-25 – discussion was held regarding the vote that was taken on 2/15/25 and Shelly discussed that she did not think the vote should have taken place without the Treasurer being present and due to not being in position long enough. Kim chimed in with respect to time on job and standard raise cadence and the fact that the vote should be revoked due to Central Office being in revoked status. Both acknowledged that it was not a personal issue and that she deserves compensation that should be reviewed when in good standing. Melissa said that she believes that the vote should be upheld because we had a quorum based on current bylaws regardless of if we were in good standing or not because no money is being exchanged. Kara said as chair this is the only time she gets to vote and she votes for increase to stand. Shannon pointed out that at the time the vote was taken we were still operating.

Kim W asked Melissa how far into the month she was paid. Melissa was paid though 2/15/25. Kim noted that she should have been paid though 2/23/25 when we had the emergency meeting and the committee was notified that we were in revoked status. Discussion was held a great length and varying opinions were shared. Kim said we should pay the Office Manager salary for the week of 2/16/25-2/23/25 in the amount of \$300.00 just like any other bill. It was decided to table the Office Manager compensation during the closure and revisit once in good standing.

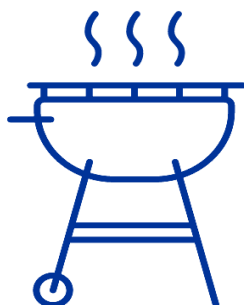

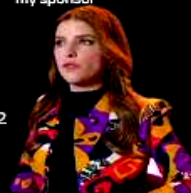
